Workshops

Life Skills Education

The interactive session on 'Life Skills Education' was taken by our respected Principal ma'am on 7 Jan'23 for the teachers. Life skills are not sacrosanct or definitive. It changes from time to time while some skills remain the same. Life skills are not related to the body but the mind also. It means to develop abilities for adaptive and positive behavior.

The sessions focused on self-awareness, empathy, creative and critical thinking, decision making, effective communication, problem solving, interpersonal skills, coping with emotions & stress. The session was insightful and will help teachers to implement life skills to make teaching-learning more successful.

Mental Health Session

Our school organized an enlightening session on Mental Health Session for teachers on 6 Jan 2023 which was conducted by Dr. Swati Mittal, a Psychiatrist (M.D, M.B.B.S) who is working at Fortis Hospital, Noida.

The session highlighted the importance of mental health, how to deal with depression, the importance of self-love, practicing gratitude and how to work on your happiness. The session focused on the importance of giving time to your kids, reading books in your leisure time, and giving priority to your brain. The five points recommended by the Psychiatrist to follow are that one should walk daily, read a book, spend quality time with kids and oneself, stop eating sweets, and mirror talk. The session was well organized, the content was engaging, and the discussions were relatable. Overall, it was a wonderful session.

Workshop On Road Safety Drive



A workshop on traffic rules and road safety was conducted for the students of classes X and XI on 26th November 2022 in the school campus. The students were briefed about the various traffic rules that ought to be followed to maintain safety on the roads. They were encouraged to follow the rules because the slightest mistake on the road can lead to a fatal accident. Common and careless mistakes committed by people were described in the session. The first point stressed upon was the importance of wearing a helmet to keep the head safe as it is the most sensitive part of the body. The second point discussed the golden rules to follow when walking on the road. Several videos were shown to the students to reinforce the information shared. They understood the consequences of over speeding, signal jumping, carelessness, not using the seat belt or wearing a helmet, the use of a mobile phone on the road and many other unlawful practices on the road. Questionnaires were given to students to check the outcome of the sessions. A quiz on identifying the traffic signals was conducted. Students pledged to follow traffic rules in their lives.

The workshop was a huge success as it helped spread awareness and create traffic ambassadors who will further spread the message of obeying traffic rules and ensuring road safety. Thus, awakening in the young students a spirit of citizenship!


Times of India - Literary fest 2023


SKELETAL SYSTEM AND NERVOUS SYSTEM







NATIONAL CONSTITUTION DAY

A talk on the topic 'Democracy is better than Autocracy' and an interesting activity of 'Design your pledge' for school was also organized.


Students created wonderful documents of their commitments towards themselves, their school and their nation. The day served as a reminder to live by and promote these timeless values in our communities.


